

LETTER TO PARENTS

From the Camp Judah Board of Pastors

Dear Parent,

We are pleased to introduce you to a unique and amazing children's summer camp called "Camp Judah". We, the pastoral leadership of Camp Judah, work hard to provide a safe and fun-filled environment where your child can build new and lasting friendships, enjoy a variety of exciting camp activities, experience God's love and learn more about His plan for their lives. Our vision for Camp Judah is to provide an atmosphere where kids and teens can encounter the Living God for themselves. We long to see these precious children raised up to believe for and pursue God's destiny on their lives. Every year, we hear of many awesome testimonies of changed lives experienced by campers who encountered the Lord at Camp Judah.

We recognize that entrusting the care of your child for a week of summer camp can be a parent's primary concern, and we want you to know that your child's safety and protection is a sacred trust that we do not take lightly. Each year, we endeavor to review policy and establish guidelines to ensure your child's safety and well-being.

Each of our volunteer staff members are accepted only after careful pastoral review of their detailed application, a background check through the registry provided by New York State, and a personal reference from their own pastor. Campers are divided up according to gender and age group and assigned to individual small cabin groups. Each cabin group has assigned to it, one trained and qualified Cabin Counselor and for Jr. Camp we also provide at least one qualified Counselor-In-Training. In addition, we also provide a qualified camp director and assistant directors to oversee the camp program as a whole. In compliance with the guidelines of the New York State Health Department, we also have on staff, a licensed registered nurse who remains on site for the entire week of camp to provide for any medical needs your child may require. Finally, we have at least two Elim Fellowship pastors on the camp grounds, throughout the week to provide pastoral oversight.

The reason we invest so much time, energy and expense into Camp Judah is because we sincerely care about kids and the call of God on their lives. We just wanted to let you know that we will continue to do all we can to ensure the safety and well-being of every child, in recognition of their precious value, and we will create an environment that encourages them to pursue wholeheartedly after the Lord.
